

## 2017 SPRING PACIFIC GAP GRANT APPLICATION FORM

The purpose of the University of the Pacific Spring 2017 “Gap Grant” is to provide selected Pacific students a one-time supplemental grant to help secure their financial stability. Grants are not intended to cover a students’ entire outstanding balance. Instead, Gap Grants represent an intent by the University to assist a student, by partnering with them to aid them in constructing a viable financial plan. To qualify for a “Gap Grant” the following criteria should be noted:

- Students applying for a Gap Grant must have unmet need
- Grants are for the 2017 Spring semester only and do not represent continuing additional financial support.
- Grants are intended to provide “gap” support and most grants will be between \$250 and \$750\*\*
- Students must possess an outstanding balance of less than \$1,500-\$2,000, and the ability to make up the remaining difference
- Grant recipients must have exercised all Federal Loan eligibility (i.e. Stafford and Perkins).

Please answer the following questions to provide more information in support of your application. Please note question responses are limited to 350 characters.

1. What is your current outstanding Student Account balance?
2. Why do you feel you qualify for additional funding now i.e. what has changed that requires additional funding that you are unable to cover?
3. If you receive additional funding that will cover part, but not all of your outstanding balance, what is your plan for making up the difference i.e. do you intend to pay the balance off completely or enroll in a monthly payment plan?
4. When do you expect to graduate?
5. If you are enrolled in a monthly payment plan, what are your plans to complete your payment obligations and what are your plans for any future terms at Pacific?

*\*\*Students who have financial need resulting from significant changes from Fall or Spring and who possess balances which exceed the Gap Grant limits will be reviewed by the Financial Aid Office. Please direct inquiries to a Financial Aid counselor for a personalized review. Additional documentation, such as tax return transcript or other financial documentation may be required to complete a full evaluation.*
